This position is based in the Research, Assessment and Monitoring (RAM) Unit of the United Nations World Food Programme (WFP) Regional Bureau for Western Africa (RBD) in Dakar, Senegal. Under the overall guidance of the Senior RAM Advisor, the Vulnerability Analysis & Mapping Officer (Data Analyst) will report to the RAM Officer (Food Security and Market Analyst) and be part of the RAM Unit's Pillar 2 (FSNMA).

PURPOSE:

To deliver budget and resource analysis and programming activities, and provide support to Country Offices, partnering with and supporting managers in the application of best practice approaches for the efficient, effective, and compliant utilization of funds.

ACCOUNTABILITIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

Support on refining and extending R based interface/syntax for consolidating/standardizing country level Food Security Estimates into a regional database.

Support in the modelling of food security data and projections of price data to facilitate better planning of WFP operations.

Support COs/RBD in price data upload on Databridge, update regional dashboard and market assessments data processing.

Promote the use of new information and communication technologies for the collection of survey data within WFP (RBD/COs) and its partners (Government/NGOs) through capacity building on the development and use for data analysis.

Contribute to the development of VAM projects and activities, plans and processes, ensuring alignment with wider WFP policies and guidance.

Support the development of systems and tools for the monitoring and assessment of food assistance needs in line with innovative methodologies and best practice.

Support the development of food security and vulnerability analysis and the preparation of timely reports on food assessment needs in line with wider VAM policies, processes and guidance to enable effective decision-making on the development of country strategy, policies and programmes.

Provide assistance on the coordination of data gathering and monitoring systems ensuring that rigorous quality standards are maintained.
